Subject: Eels Lake Water Level

We have owned property on Eels Lake since 1969 and find that the maintenance of the water level has become more erratic during the past few years.

We encourage the TSW to listen to the concerns of the residents of Eels Lake and to consider implementing a more consistent approach to the setting of the water levels. We believe that there should be a minimum level established for the lake at various dates from spring until late fall and that the level should be dropped in small increments rather than, as was done in mid-August, removing eight logs at once, only to have two replaced shortly after. The minimum levels should allow boating throughout the summer months and should be suitable for any fish which may be spawning.
