Kennisis Lake was down by 9.5ft by the first wk of September. The tadpoles in our bay died by the hundreds with such a rapid loss of water. My dock had to be brought in on Labour day wkend. I don't mind sharing resources but I will be damned if we allow the TSW and its adjoining lakes to completely manipulate a 100yo contract meant for commercial transportation to their benefit.

The TSW and its adjoining lakes should have mandated low-flow toilets/faucets/shower heads. Drawing water from their lakes to water their lawns should be restricted. A 4-6inch overall decrease in their current water levels will have minimal effects on their ecosystem but will save our head lakes almost 3ft!!! The draft on their pleasure boats in no-way approaches that of the old commercial transportation barrages.

Think about reverse flow water piping (like most large canals) that can reclaim out flowing water.

I pay taxes no differently than those on the TSW and thus expect equal treatment. A 100yo contract for commercial transportation does not give TSW residents the right to be robber-barons.
